MicroPlanet Products Being Deployed to Manage Voltage and Save Energy at Flying J Travel Plazas and Fuel Stops

California pilot converts to commercial roll out after reducing Flying J's electric energy consumption by 8.78%

Seattle, WA. – October 20, 2008 – MicroPlanet, (MP:TSXV & MCTYF:OTC) a clean technology, energy conservation company, announced today that Flying J Inc. has placed an order to install MicroPlanet's commercial 3-Phase voltage management systems in its travel plazas and fuel stops located in North America, to save energy and reduce expenses. The first 3 systems will be installed in early 2009, followed by an additional 7 locations when the testing and training procedures are accepted by Flying J. The order is valued at approximately \$300,000 US.

Flying J conducted a pilot program over a six month period to test the effectiveness of MicroPlanet voltage management products at one of its facilities in California. The results of the pilot indicated the MicroPlanet voltage management technology will reduce **kWh consumption at their facilities an average of 8.78%**.

"The results of the Flying J pilot tests and the subsequent commercial order, continues the validation that our new commercial 3-Phase products are being rapidly adopted to reduce energy consumption and lower electrical bills. MicroPlanet's products are now being deployed on a large scale by both businesses and utilities as a cost effective way to save energy, improve power quality and reduce greenhouse emissions. Following the successful installation of these 10 systems, we expect to work with the management at Flying J on installing our systems in their other facilities." said Bruce Lisanti, CEO of MicroPlanet.

Flying J Inc., an Ogden, Utah based corporation, is the largest retail distributor of diesel fuel in North America and is among the top 20 in Forbes' 500 Largest Private Companies in America with 2007 sales exceeding \$16.2 billion. This fully integrated oil company currently employs over 16,000 people nationwide through its interstate operations, transportation, refining and supply, exploration and production as well as its financial services and communications divisions. Flying J's sophisticated network of over 250 state-of-the-art travel plazas and fuel stops is located along national highways in 41 states and six Canadian Provinces. Another 30 facilities are presently under construction or in various stages of the permitting process with openings scheduled throughout the next two years. www.FlyingJ.com

MicroPlanet has signed multiple pilot agreements in 2008 with major fast food, grocery and convenience store chains to install the Company's voltage management systems in locations throughout the US. The results of these pilots are demonstrating that MicroPlanet's voltage management technology can reduce electric energy consumption in commercial environments from 5% to 12%, without requiring customers to make any other changes in usage behavior or equipment.

MicroPlanet's voltage management technology improves power quality at the point of delivery for a home or business and dynamically raises or lowers in addition to balancing incoming voltage to an optimal and constant set point which saves energy and reduces maintenance costs.
